In view of the above, you are requested not to admit any fresh batch of MBBS students at your medical college for the academic year 2008-09 and furnish the compliance report on the observations made MCI in its inspection report dated 21.10.2008 to this Ministry at appropriate time for consideration for renewal of permission for the admission of 4th batch of MBBS students for the next academic year 2009-10.
