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BYE-LAWS OF SHAFA EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY NANDYAL-518501 ANDHRA PRADESH.

SHAFA EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY, NANDYAL. MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

I. Name of the Society

: SHAFA EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY, NANDYAL.

a) Registered office

: Shafa Educational Society,

Door No.25/602, Sreenivasa Nagar, Nandyal 518501,

Nandyal Dist, Andhra Pradesh, India. 50

II. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

A) The main objectives of the society shall be:

 To promote educational awareness among citizens of India irrespective of caste, creed, race, region and religion.

- 2. To promote, establish, maintain and assist or aid in maintaining educational and other institutions in backward Rural India with philanthropic approach with commitment in building the society for Social, Cultural and educational development of the country by providing School education, Intermediate education, Degree education, Engineering, Pharmacy, Management, Computer applications, Medical, Dental, Nursing, Ph.D. and Biotechnology and other Professional and Cultural education to the youth of India.
- To establish institutions with prime objective of teaching which helps in attending
 the strategic needs of the country and to focus on historic culture of India and to
 implement methodology for environment preservation by using renewable energy
 sources.
- To establish Deemed to be universities or private universities or Institutions for the youth of Rural India and help them in re-building the Nation.
- The Society gives priority to schedule caste, scheduled tribes and economically weaker sections as per Govt. norms for men and women of rural areas to get well educated and better employed.

- 6. To conduct seminars, symposiums, workshops, conferences, Aumgi meets and invite experts from India and abroad through Education exchange programs to improve the quality of education.
- 7. The society will start Institutions like Deemed to be university or private university and all other Educational Institutions including professional and general institutions for both men and women of Rural India.
- 8. To act as Society or Trust Board, to accept endowments, donations, subscriptions, grants etc. paid voluntarily either in cash or in kind from other institutions, individuals, corporate bodies, and Governments and to undertake the management or administration of any trust or institutions on such terms as may be agreed upon.
- 9. To carry on any such activity or activities of a charitable nature and of public utility as may be approved by the members of the general body from time to time.
- 10. To establish Universities of repute for quality education and research.
- B) The ancillary objectives of the society for the purpose of attaining any or all of the afore said main objectives are:
- 1. To secure affiliation of any recognized university or other institutions in India or Abroad for conducting courses leading to the examinations for award of under graduates, post graduates, Research Scholars and doctoral degrees, all diplomas of such universities or institutions.
- 2. To conduct examinations of its own and award of diplomas and degrees etc., or issue certificates of recognition and to award scholarships, stipends, prizes, fellowships, traveling grants and otherwise aid to poor and deserving students and research scholars.
- 3. To enroll members and to collect funds by membership fees, donations, subscriptions or by any other means as may be considered expedient by the

general body of the society from time to time. To raise funds from philanthropists or other association or voluntary organizations or well-wishers.

- 4. To publish journals, magazines or other media for diffusion of useful knowledge.
- 5. To organize and maintain contacts, to secure affiliation and to collaborate on a reciprocal basis with similar institutions in India and other countries.
- 6. To acquire by purchase or sell any or all movable or immovable properties, or otherwise any rights or privileges including rights in immovable properties for the betterment and to achieve objectives of the society.
- 7. To approach and enter into agreements with Central or State Governments, Local authorities, Universities or any other private or public bodies for securing grants on such terms and conditions as such authorities or bodies may stipulate and as are acceptable to the society.
- 8. To borrow, guarantee, raise or otherwise procure funds on the security of movable and immovable or other assets of the society or otherwise for carrying on all or any of the objectives of the society at the discretion of the General Body subject to such limits, if any, as may be prescribed by the General Body of the society from time to time from Bankers or Financial institutions or individuals on payment of required interest, if any.

- B) Certified that the society does not engage in agitational activities to ventilate its grievance and no political activity are involved in it.

I. NAME OF THE SOCIETY : SHAFA EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY, NANDYAL!

II. MEMBERSHIP

 Membership can be obtained by any one exceeding 18 years of age and in agreement with the spirit of Society by making application to the General Body. Members shall consist of

- i) Founder member
- ii) Life Member
- iii) Ordinary Member
- 2. All signatories to this memorandum and Articles of Association are the founder members and all founder members shall be life members of the Society also.
- **3.** Any person applying for a Life Membership, upon acceptance by the General Body with 3/4th majority, shall pay an admission fee of Rs.5 lakhs and no further annual subscription will be paid by the Life Member.
- 4. An ordinary member, upon acceptance of his application by the General Body with 3/4th majority, shall pay an admission fee of Rs.1 lakhs and annual subscription of Rs.25000/- before 1st of September of every year which is considered as due date.
- **5.** Companies, firms, institutions or Association of person or any other person as per Income Tax Act, 1961 are also entitled for the membership of Life member and ordinary member.
- 6. It shall be open to the founder members and life members to nominate any person from his family to succeed to him/ her in case of occurrence of death within a period of two years.

PRESIDENT PRESIDENT

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7. In the event of any vacancy arising without such nomination on the death of founder member and life member with in a period of two years from the date of his becoming member preference shall be given for admission to founder membership and life membership in such vacancy to his/her eldest son or wife or husband or eldest daughter or any other member of that family duly nominated by a majority of its family members provided an amount of rupees one lakh is paid with in a period of Six months from the date of death of such founder member and life member.

8. Termination of Membership

The membership shall be terminated

- a) On Resignation of the member
- b) On adjudication as insolvent
- c) On death of a member
- d) By the General Body with simple majority on the recommendation of the sub- committee appointed by General Body to enquire into the activities of any member found to be acting against the interest of the society and if such sub- committee recommends that continuation of such member is detrimental to the interest of the society after affording such member an opportunity of explanation against such proposal.
- 9. On failure of payment of annual subscription by an ordinary member for two consecutive years, a notice of failure to pay the annual subscription shall be sent to the member by Regd. Post to the address or through mail or WhatsApp of the member available in the application form and any changes as may be initiated by the member giving 15 days' time for payment of dues. Any member who fails to pay annual subscription is not entitled to participate and vote in the General body meeting of that particular year until and unless the dues are cleared.
- 10. Any failure to pay the dues within 1 month after receipt of the notice, would result in an automatic loss of membership of society without any further act by the society or the General Body.

11. It shall be open to such an ordinary member to apply for re-admission, without payment of normal admission fee within 6 months of loss of membership to the Managing Committee and re-admission of such a member shall at the sole discretion of the General Body.

12. Members of the governing body/Managing Committee shall be elected once in a year in the General body meeting.

III. GENERAL BODY

 The General body of the society shall consist of all types of members to which ever category they belong under clause II (1) above.

2. Functions of the General Body

i. The General body shall meet at least once in every year in the month of September or any extended date as may be decided by the governing body and such meeting shall be called annual General Body Meeting.

It shall have the following powers:

- a) To review the activities of the society and also to scrutinise and accept the list of donors during the year under review.
- b) To issue suitable instructions to the Governing Body for the society.
- c) To setup guidelines and targets to the Governing Body for the achievement of objectives of the society.
- d) To review and approve the audited Statement of accounts of the society and organisations under its management for the previous years.
- e) To Discuss and pass the annual budget of the society as recommended by the Governing Body for the ensuing year or with such modifications or alterations as it may deem fit and proper.
- ii. The General Body shall have the power to add, amend, alter, repeal or cancel from time to time any of the purposes for which the society is established as contained in clause II (B) (8) of the MOA in accordance with the procedure laid down under the Society Registration Act 1860.

- iii. Any of the clause of AOA of society may be amended by the General Body with a majority of 3/4th of the members present or by proxy, provided that no amendment to add, alter or delete in any clause of the MOA and AOA of the society shall be made without the approval of 3/4th Majority of the governing body and also commissioner of Income Tax.
- iv. The General Body shall have power to appoint auditors for the society and its affiliated organisation and fix their remuneration.

v. The General Body shall have powers as necessary or incidental for carrying out the objectives of the society.

3. Meeting of General Body

a. Ordinary Meeting

The ordinary meeting of the General Body should be convened by the secretary with 15 clear days of notice once in a year.

b. Emergency Meeting

The President or secretary may convene any emergency meeting on its own initiative to transact any matters of urgent importance with notice of 7 days.

c. Every notice of the General body meeting shall be accompanied with an agenda listing out the issues which shall be placed before the General body.

IV. MANAGEMENT.

The overall management and administration of the society and its affiliated organisation shall vest with Governing Body, duly constituted.

V. GOVERNING BODY.

- 1. The governing body shall consist of
 - President
- 2. Vice-President
- Secretary
- 4. Joint-Secretary
- Treasurer
- 6. Four Executive Committee members.

Provided however any casual vacancy arising among the members of the governing body or the Executive committee by resignation, death or any type of disqualification as contained therein or by application of any enactment to the society may be filled by the governing body and the person or persons so

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appointed shall hold office on the residuary period during the terms of office of the member in whose place he is chosen.

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2. Elections

- a. The existing governing body shall hold office till the next governing body is elected at the annual general body meeting.
- **b.** The Governing body shall elect Executive committee consisting of 9 (Nine) members from among the founder Members, Life members and ordinary members.

3. Functions of Governing Body

Without prejudice to the generalities of powers conferred in the General Body under article III (2), the Governing body shall have the power and shall specifically perform the following functions.

- a) To lay down and periodically review the policy of the society.
- b) To promote, establish, affiliate Educational Institutions and establish deemed to be universities or Private universities individually and independently and exercises general control over such institutions.
- c) To acquire by purchase or by lease or otherwise to sell, to lease or otherwise, transfer any of the movable or immovable properties required for or owned by the society or any of the institutions maintained by the society for attaining the objectives of the society with prior approval of the general body.
- d) To prepare and submit annual budget of the society for approval by the General body and to approve annual budgets for the institutions maintained by the society.
- e) To construct, alter, re-model and maintain any buildings that are required for the use of the society or with the prior approval of the General Body of any of the institutions maintained by the society.
- f) To take necessary legal steps to sue others and to defend the society in legal proceedings to safe guard the interest of the society or any of the institutions maintained by the society.

- g) To arrange for collection of funds by way of Donations Grants and other means like conducting benefit performance etc. for the benefit of the society.
- h) To maintain regular accounts of the society, to get the annual receipts and payments accounts, Income & Expenditure accounts and Balance sheet prepared and audited by the Statutory Auditors and place them before the General Body for approvals.
- i) To receive the application for enrolment of general membership and reserve the right to reject the application with 3/4th majority of the Governing body.
- j) To have full control and supervision over the affairs of the institutions maintained by the society and for that purpose to have full access to all the records, accounts and other documents of the said institutions, the power to appoint any person or a committee to enquire into any of the aspects of the affairs of the such institutions and to consider such reports and take appropriate action thereon.
- k) To appoint required faculty and administrative staff including Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff of the Institutions maintained by the society to meet the norms of the Regulatory Bodies and to scrutinize the performance of such staff member from time to time.
- To be the custodian of all the properties of the society.
- m) To have the power to borrow or otherwise raise funds for the purpose of spending the same to achieve any of the objectives of the society, with in the limits, if any, that may be stipulated by the members from time to time and for that purpose mortgage or pledge any of the properties of the society or the institutions maintained by the society with prior approval of the General Body.

4. Meetings of the Governing Body

- a. The Governing body shall meet at least once in every three months.
- **b.** The meeting of the Governing body will be convened by the secretary.
- c. The notice for the meeting will be sent to the members Seven days in advance either by certificate of posting or mail or WhatsApp or personally by the secretary.

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- d. The notice can be waived by the members of the Governing Body whenever applicable at the time of meeting held.
- e. All the resolutions in the governing body will be passed by a simple majority.
- f. In case of tie, the president of governing body shall have a casting vote.
- g. The quorum for the Governing Body shall be consisting of 3/5th of the members. The president of the managing committee shall preside over all the meeting and in his absence, the vice-president will act as president for such meeting.
- h. The proceedings of the Governing body/ Managing Committee meeting will be reduced into minutes and the same shall be signed by the president and signed by all the members attended the meeting. The minutes shall be maintained in a Minutes Book and such a minute book shall be kept only at the registered office of the society. The minutes of such meeting shall be circulated to all the members for their information.
- i. The venue for the meeting of the governing body shall be determined by the governing body from time to time.

5. POWER AND DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS

A. PRESIDENT

The president shall preside over, all the meeting of the general body and the governing body. The president shall perform such other functions as are entrusted to him under these articles elsewhere and by the governing body. President shall be entitled to call for any record or document of the society for his information.

B. VICE PRESIDENT

In the absence of the president, the vice president will preside over the meetings of general body and governing body and shall perform all such functions as may be entrusted by the governing body including the functions of the president in his absence.




C. SECRETARY

- i) The secretary shall be the chief executive and shall be responsible for the routine administration of the society and for carrying out all the decisions of the Governing Body.
- ii) He shall act as Ex-officio correspondent of all the educational institutions owned and maintained by the society, unless separate correspondent or correspondents are appointed for such institutions by the governing body.
- iii) He shall perform the secretarial functions like preparing a notice and agenda of the meeting of the Governing body and recording minutes of the proceeding entering into and carrying on with all correspondence with the Government, Universities and other authorities.

while acting as Ex-officio correspondent of the institutions, He shall

- a) Look after the day to day administration of the respective institutions.
- b) Call for and obtain from the heads of the institutions such information as may be required by the AICTE, NMC/MCI, DCI, PCI, INC etc., and concerned universities, central and state Govts, UGC or any other statutory authorities for the courses conducted by the Institutions.
- c) Have the power to award punishment such as suspension or withholding increment to any of the members of the staff, subject to giving a right of appeal being available to such aggrieved staff.
- d) Implement all the directions, central and state government orders and proceedings of University Grants Commission (UGC), National Medical Commission(NMC), Dental Council of India, Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), Indian Nursing Council (INC), All India Council for Technical education (AICTE) and concerned University authorities and any other statutory authorities and local bodies.
- e) He shall be in charge of all the records of society and shall be responsible for their proper custody.
- He shall be empowered to sued and be liable to be sued in the name of the society.
- g) He is empowered to delegate any of his powers to any of the office bearer from time to time as he may deem fit.
- h) He will perform such other functions as are entrusted to him under these articles.

PRESIDENT PRESIDENT



D. JOINT SECRETARY

The joint secretary shall assist the secretary in all the day to day affairs of the society and the institutions being run by the society where he is required to do so by the secretary.


E. TREASURER

- 1. The treasurer shall be the chief custodian of all the properties, Assets and funds of the society.
- He shall make disbursements in respect of bills and other payments passed by the secretary.
- He shall be responsible for proper maintenance of the accounts of the society together with the bills, vouchers and other documents and for preparation of annual budgets and final accounts of the society.
- 4. He shall periodically scrutinize the accounts of the institutions maintained by the society.
- 5. He shall perform such other functions as are entrusted to him under these Articles of Association.

VI. FUNDS

- Funds of the society hereby constituted shall include the contributions of the member's voluntary donations collected from the individuals, public bodies and loans raised from the public or financial institutions.
- 2. All the funds of the society, other than those required for immediate disbursements, shall be deposited with any Nationalised or Non-Nationalised banks in the name of the society and all the bank accounts of the society shall be operated by the PRESIDENT only. All the bank accounts of the institutions which are running under this society shall be operated by the President of the Society in the capacity of Chairman.
- 3. The funds of the society shall be spent only for the attainment of the objectives of the society and no portion thereof shall be paid, transferred, or diverted, directly or indirectly to any of its members in any manner whatsoever. Provided however, that any member rendering services to the society or to the institutions maintained by the society may be remunerated for such services in such manner as the governing body may decide from time to time.

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VII. AMENDMENTS

- Subject to sub-clause hereunder, the general body consisting of all classes of members of the society shall have the power to add, amend, repeal or cancel from time to time any of the objectives of the society as contained in clause II of the Memorandum of Association in accordance with the procedure laid down in section 12 of the societies registration act XXI of 1860.
- Subject to sub-clause hereunder, any of the clauses of the articles of association
 of the society may be amended by the members by a resolution passed at a
 general body meeting with 3/4th (three fourth) majority of the members present.
- 3. No amendments to any of the clauses of the memorandum and articles of association of the society shall be passed, after the society is recognized as a charitable society under the Income tax Act, unless prior approval of the Commissioner of Income tax is obtained for such amendment.

VIII. DISSOLUTION OF THE SOCIETY

In the event of the dissolution of the society, all the remaining funds and assets of the society after meeting all the liabilities, shall be transferred to any association or body having similar aims and objectives and which is recognized by the Income Tax authorities as a charitable association and under no circumstances the funds or assets of the society shall be distributed among the members of the society.
